Baler duo - a winning concept

Challenges with waste collections made this a priority, and Orwak Easi UK provided them with two balers for the main recyclable waste streams. The small COMPACT 3075 for the polythene and the ORWAK 3500 heavy duty mill-size baler for the cardboard proved to be an ideal combination.



As always, Orwak Easi offered a free trial to ensure the recommended solutions were the right fit and they were! They only make one bale per week in each machine, but the investment is no doubt worthwhile, as it brings many benefits:

- Saving time on flat-packing cardboard and taking multiple trips to the bins with full bags of polythene!
